Medication in school

If your son/daughter needs to take any medication during the school day, including paracetamol or ibuprofen, the medication must be handed in to the school office, along with a completed 'Student Medication Request' form, which can be found on our website or obtained from the school office. All medication must come in the original packaging.

No student, with the exception of Asthma Inhalers and Adrenaline Auto Injectors, is permitted to have medication in their possession whilst on school site. If your son/daughter has a new diagnosis and requires an Asthma Inhaler or Adrenaline Auto Injector please amend your data collection details via the SIMS Parent App or contact the School Office.

You will already have been asked to give permission for the administration of paracetamol to your son/daughter if considered necessary. Any paracetamol/medication administered at school is logged in the main office with details stamped in the student planner.
