As schools are expected to remain closed for the foreseeable future, Tomlinscote will only be able to continue to accommodate a very small number of students after the Easter break, in order to support our community.

Only two specific groups can be catered for:

- Group 1 the children of Key Workers.
- Group 2 children with an EHCP, Looked After Children and children with a Social Worker attached to the family.

All other children will need to continue to stay at home where there is a safe alternative.

If you indicated in the Google form that you wish your child(ren) to attend school, then the following is appropriate:

- The school will be open at 8.30am and until 3.05pm.
- Students will need their iPad, exercise books, a reading book and writing resources.
- Students can wear normal clothes (following normal mufti guidance).
- A packed lunch will need to be brought in (food will be available for students who normally receive a Free School Meal).
