



Dear all,

Thank you for your correspondence regarding the distressing pedestrian injury that occurred on Wednesday , 9 June, on Old Bisley Road in close proximity to Ravenscote School. My thoughts and those of my colleagues are with the family and friends of the young person involved.

Surrey Police are investigating the incident, supported by Surrey Highways. Until the investigation is complete we do not know what factors may have led to this incident.

I fully understand and share the concerns expressed by parents and residents that have written to us about this incident and the desire to see more road safety improvements put in place. However, until we understand the cause of this incident, we cannot determine what improvements may be necessary. An initial site assessment has already taken place, and colleagues from our Road Safety Team have met with the Headteacher of Ravenscote School and Tomlinscote.

A wider assessment of road safety issues will shortly be undertaken in and around both schools, and this will supplement the formal assessments that have been carried out for Ravenscote and St Augustine's Schools. In addition, we are planning to undertake a school road safety assessment in partnership with Tomlinscote School later this year. A follow-up assessment of the effectiveness of the safety improvement scheme introduced in Upper Chobham Road outside of Ravenscote School will also take place later this year, but this is not in any way linked to the location of the recent incident.
