Dear Parents and Carers

Early closure on 23rd September 2021 and late opening on 24th September 2021

As mentioned in the newsletter, this year we are holding an Open Evening for Year 6 parents and students on Thursday 23rd September. It starts at 5.30pm and runs to 8.30pm.

In order for us to prepare for the evening, the school will close early on Thursday 23rd September at 12.45pm. The Bee Hive will be open for lunch as normal at 11.50am for Years 8 & 10 and also for those students who receive free school meals at their timetabled lunch time. If childcare is a concern for anyone during the afternoon, then there will be supervision in the Bee Hive and students are welcome to stay at school until 3pm. They will need to register in the Bee Hive at 12.45pm with the member of staff.

The school will open later on Friday 24th September and students should arrive at 10.40am for breaktime, ready to go to Period 3. Students can come on site earlier if transport to school is a problem and sit in the Bee Hive. Food and drink can be purchased as normal.

Nearly 500 students will be involved across the year groups in order to participate in the activities, play in the band, support in the subject areas and speak to our visitors. In addition, Years 7, 8 & 9 students will lead the parents and students around the school in small groups. Thank you to everyone who has completed the parental consent Google form if your child is attending during the evening. All parental pickups after the Open Evening at 8.40pm will be from the back gate. If you do wish your child to walk home, they must have a note signed by their parent to show on the evening.
