Dear Parent / Carer,

A very warm welcome to you. Thank you for your interest in our school. We have the honour of leading Tomlinscote School and Sixth Form College and this letter accompanies the prospectus for families who have sons or daughters in Year 6 attending local schools. We hope it helps you and your child with the process of moving to secondary school. We are very proud of the exceptional success of our students – Ofsted has judged the school to be ‘Outstanding’ and we gained record GCSE results in 2017. We understand that finding the right school for your child is very important to you. The purpose of this letter is to explain the opportunities we are able to provide to judge how our school matches the education you are looking for.

Tomlinscote students have a well-deserved reputation for excellence. This is true academically, in their sporting and musical achievements, in their outstanding behaviour and through their respect for each other and adults they work with. In terms of examinations we have two aims: high attainment – the best raw grades; and outstanding progress – whatever the starting point, students will make more progress than similar students in other schools. We recognise the importance of gaining great qualifications and we provide an environment in which learning is the only focus and nothing is allowed to obstruct this. You will see this for yourselves. Our students regularly secure places at prestigious universities and provide excellent role models for younger students. Our prospectus summarises key aspects of our school and we hope it will help you understand our values and standards. However, the best way to learn about our school is to visit and we hope you will take the opportunity to attend our Information Evening on 26th September, and subsequently return for a morning tour of the school, to see the reality for yourselves.

Excellent examination results and exemplary behaviour, led Ofsted to award the school an **‘Outstanding’ judgement, both for teaching and overall**. This is an honour given to a small number of schools and offers you the assurance that learning and care are of the very highest standards. This sits alongside the school’s status as a ‘High Performing Specialist School’, our main specialism as a Language College and the second specialism of Applied Learning – with the Vocational Centre providing state of the art facilities. We are also an Academy and this gives us even more flexibility to provide the most stimulating learning environment and significant investment in excellent facilities. This year’s fantastic record-breaking 79% of Year 11 securing at least 5 good GCSE grades is evidence of the success this brings for all who attend our school.

Visitors recognise that the school is a well-ordered community in which individuals are valued and respected. Students are encouraged to achieve in all aspects of school life and the academic and pastoral systems within the school are geared towards this end. Progress is assessed carefully and reported regularly to help parents monitor the progress of their son or daughter.

- An Information Evening will be held for parents and their children in the main hall at Tomlinscote on **Tuesday, 26th September, 2017**. To help with organisation and to improve your comfort, we ask families with children attending **Ravenscote, St. Augustine's, Connaught and Crawley Ridge schools to attend the 6.00pm session** with those from **Hammond, The Grove, Mytchett, Frimley C of E and Lakeside the 7.30pm session**. After each talk, there will be an opportunity to ask questions of staff, students and current parents. If your child attends another school, or this time is inconvenient, you are of course welcome to attend the other session.
