English Language

2 papers, both worth 80 marks each

Paper 1 'Explorations in creative reading and writing'

Section A - 40 marks. This is made up of 4 questions based on the source they read in the exam. They are assessed on their ability to read, analyse and evaluate fiction writing.

Section B - 40 marks. This assesses the students on their ability to write either a piece of descriptive writing or a narrative, focussing on the content and organisation, communication, vocabulary, devices as well as spelling, punctuation and grammar.

Paper 2 'Writers' viewpoints and perspectives'

Section A - 40 marks. This is made up of 4 questions based on 2 non-fiction sources the students have read. They are assessed on their ability to infer, analyse language and compare viewpoints within a pre 20th century source and a 20th or 21st century source.

Section B - 40 marks. Students are expected to respond to a controversial statement. They will be set a task to respond in a particular form and with a purpose to either explain, argue or persuade their audience of their viewpoint on the subject matter. Again, they are assessed on the content and organisation, communication, vocabulary, devices as well as spelling, punctuation and grammar.

What will I be assessed on in my mock?

Literature Paper 1 - Modern text and 19th- century novel

Students will answer 1 question on 'An Inspector Calls' and one question on 'Strange Case of Dr Jekyll and Mr Hyde'. Both are worth 30 marks and students are assessed on AO1, AO2 and AO3.

Literature Paper 2 - Shakespeare and Unseen Poetry

Students will answer 1 question on 'Macbeth' and two questions on unseen poetry that are provided in the exam.

The 'Macbeth' essay is assessed on AO1, AO2, AO3 and AO4.

The unseen poetry essay is assessed on AO1, AO2 and AO4.

The unseen poetry comparison is assessed on AO2.

English Literature Assessment Objectives (AOs)

AO1

Read, understand and respond to texts. Students should be able to:

- maintain a critical style and develop an informed personal response
- use textual references, including quotations, to support and illustrate interpretations.

AO2

Analyse the language, form and structure used by a writer to create meanings and effects, using relevant subject terminology where appropriate.

Show understanding of the relationships between texts and the contexts in which they were written.

AO4

Use a range of vocabulary and sentence structures for clarity, purpose and effect, with accurate spelling and punctuation.

Maths

Key Exam Information for 2021-22

Because of the ongoing impacts of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, there are some changes to how GCSE Mathematics will be assessed in 2022.

Formulae sheet provided in exam

For 2022 only, a formulae sheet will be provided in the exam. This means that students will be able to demonstrate their mathematical understanding without having to memorise formulae. The exam board, AQA, are now looking into its design and considering the implications for question papers and mark schemes. They will be in touch with schools to give further details as soon as possible.

Advance information on exams will be available

To help students focus their exam preparation, there will be advance information on what exams will cover. This advance information will be available by 7 February 2022, or sooner if the pandemic worsens.

What will I be assessed on in my mock?

All topics covered in Year 10 and up to mid-November in Year 11 will be assessed on the mock exams. There will be 2 x 90 minute papers. One non-calculator paper and one calculator paper.

Key Exam Information for 2021-22

Students will have been made aware that OCR have now removed one unit from the GCSE, the Practical Component. This means that students no longer need to compose an additional piece of music (OCR Set Brief) nor perform an ensemble piece.

Students will only need to submit one composition, showcasing a minimum of 2 minutes of music they've written, one solo performance on their instrument/voice, lasting a minimum of 2 minutes and finally sit a listening paper covering the four main Areas of Study.

What will I be assessed on in my mock?

You will be assessed on one unit of the GCSE course, the Listening Paper. In this paper students will be tested on the four main Areas of Study; The Concerto Through Time, Rhythms of the World, Film Music and The Conventions of Pop.
