Dear Parents and Carers,

On **Friday 11th February** we will be holding a non-uniform day, in support of our Eikon, a local charity who supports the LGBTQ+ community.

Students wearing non-school uniform on this date are expected to make a contribution of **£1** as per usual but if you are happy to make a larger contribution this will be gratefully received. Payment can be made via your child's ParentPay account and will need to be paid by 4pm on Thursday 10th February 2022.

Please note that students must be appropriately dressed for school and that the following items are not allowed:

- i) Football shirts
- ii) Clothing with offensive messages
- iii) Clothing which is excessively revealing for all students, such as very low waisted trousers, strappy tops, bare midriffs, and tiny shorts/skirts

Students are expected to adhere to the usual school rules regarding jewellery and make-up. Temporary spray-in hair colourings are not allowed.

Furthermore, where possible, students are encouraged to wear brightly coloured clothes to show their support for the LGBTQ+ community.

The non-uniform day is not compulsory, but those students not paying their £1 contribution will be expected to attend that day in full school uniform.
