Year 11 Subject Revision Evening for Parents and Carers

On Wednesday 17th January 2024, we are running our Year 11 Revision Evening which is for **parents** and carers only. The purpose of the evening is to:

- Help parents/carers understand specific exam information; for example, how many papers, what topics are included in which paper, etc.
- Inform parents/carers how they can support their child over the next few months with revision in each subject.

The evening will start at 6.00pm in the Main Hall with sessions from English, Maths and Science. Everyone will then move to A Block classrooms for three further sessions that will last 10 minutes each. Each session will be run by the Head of Subject and will be totally focused upon supporting parents with the forthcoming examinations in May 2024.

6.05-6.15pm	Session 1 – English in the Main Hall
6.15-6.25pm	Session 2 – Maths in the Main Hall
6.25-6.35pm	Session 3 – Science in the Main Hall
6.50-7.00pm	Session 4 – A Block – Option A
7.05-7.15pm	Session 5 – A Block – Option B
7.20-7.30pm	Session 6 – A Block – Option C

Please come along to the evening knowing what subject your child has in each option block. (Details of how to find this out are on the next page.) I do hope that as many parents/carers can attend this evening as possible as active parental involvement in the revision process makes a really positive difference to student outcomes.

A reminder that you can purchase blank revision cards via ParentPay at a cost of £1 per pack of 100 cards. These will then be delivered to your child via their form pigeonhole.

How to work out which sessions to go to in Option A, B and C
