Dear Parents and Carers

Medication in school

If your child needs to take any medication during the school day, including paracetamol or ibuprofen, the medication must be handed in to the school office, along with a completed 'Student Medication Request' form, which can be found on our website under Parents & Carers, Letters & Forms, Useful Forms or obtained from the school office. All medication must come in the original packaging.

No student, with the exception of Asthma Inhalers and Adrenaline Auto Injectors, is permitted to have medication in their possession whilst on school site. If your child has a new diagnosis and requires an Asthma Inhaler or Adrenaline Auto Injector please amend your data collection details via Edulink or contact the School Office.

You will already have been asked to give permission for the administration of paracetamol to your child if considered necessary. Any paracetamol or medication administered at school is logged at the student reception with details sent via Edulink.
