Dear parents & carers,

Approximately 486 students experienced a school trip last week either locally or abroad. I would like to do a public thank you to the many members of staff who gave up a lot of their own time to ensure that your child gained an experience that was slightly different to a normal classroom. Thank you also for the many positive parental emails.

The weather situation this week has created a different set of logistical problems. Making a decision to partially close is always tricky and we had to weigh up the health & safety risks with staying in school against students walking home. Thank you for the support received with this decision. The temperatures at the top of C block or A block were awful and ventilation was limited. The school has only four air conditioned classrooms and these are computer rooms! I think that the students and members of staff have coped extremely well and the measures that we introduced have helped mitigate the risk.

Some students would have noticed that we have some building work on site and this concerns our boilers. Tomlinscote boilers in C Block are being replaced after 26 years and they are being replaced with 6 smaller boilers. The old ones were on their last legs and now, if one was to break down, we can switch to a spare boiler. Furthermore, they will also be much more fuel efficient and that will reduce the high energy bills.
